



Director: Kevin Hanzlik; USA, 5 minutes, Documentary



Director: Jacob David Smith; USA, 5 minutes, Comedy



Director: Jason Weissbrod and Amos Stillwell; USA; 5 minutes, Animation


Logline: With an all austistic/neurodivergent cast, musicians, and writers, an unlikely couple explores what life would be like, together!

KALEIDOSCOPE (2025 Best Short Film Nominee)

Director: Clay Antonio; Australia, 11 minutes, Experimental Documentary

Logline: Written by students with an intellectual disability "Kaleidoscope" is a deeply emotional story about a young woman who, over time, begins to understand her father's metaphor of love as a shifting kaleidoscope—where colors and patterns endlessly change.
